

Converting From Version 6

Overview

SAT V7 will by default install into a separate directory from previous SAT installations. You should NOT attempt to install in the same directory as a previous version as this will cause the program to crash and you may well lose any in-progress seasons.

The V6 default directory is: **c:\program files\second and ten v6**

The V7 default directory is: **c:\program files\second and ten v7**

You **cannot** convert in-progress seasons from V5 directly to V7. You must first convert them in version 6 and then again in version 7.

Seasons

We recommend that you follow the instructions in order below to ensure you have the latest seasons available and also that you successfully restore your version 6 seasons

Pro and College Master Seasons

<http://www.secondandten.com/downloads.html> is where the master seasons for V7 can be downloaded from. We recommend that these files are downloaded and installed. Then, open V7 and select **Backup->Update with master Seasons**. This will ensure you have the very latest version 7 season files.

College Team Files

We recommend that you download the V7 college team pack from:

This will ensure you have the latest version of all the college teams – A significant number have been added since the latest update for V6.

Completed and In-Progress Seasons

If you have any seasons which you completed or started in V6 that you wish to keep, then you must follow these steps:

- **COMPLETE any games in progress or real time scoring games IN V6 before transferring**
- Open Version 6 and backup the required seasons (main screen, Season Tools->Backup Season)
- Copy the zip file from the \backup (or \backupC for college) directory and paste it into the same directory in V7
- Open Version 7 and restore the required seasons (main screen, Backup->Restore Season)

It is **essential** that this procedure is followed otherwise the season will not be converted properly.

User-Created Graphics and Sounds

You will need to copy across any user-created graphics and sounds you have downloaded. The easiest way is to re-download and re-install them since the files have been updated on the website to install automatically into the version 7 directory.

If you do not want to do this, then you need to copy the contents of the following directories:
